Direction: finding a path that is right for you.


Money: helping to give the means to be independent.

COMMUNITY COMPLEX NEEDS SUPPORT SERVICE

We now offer a Community Complex Needs Support Service (CCNSS) for people with learning disabilities, who have a complex range of needs and require a minimum of 1:1 support.

Our approach is centred on empowering individuals to have choice and control over:



Who they live with

Where they live.


How they build their community.

What Conditions Are Suitable For The CCNSS?

- Physical disabilities that limit undertaking everyday tasks and restrict mobility.
- Sensory impairments & sensory processing difficulties.
- Complex health needs, e.g. epilepsy, respiratory problems, dysphagia,
 Diabetes, skin integrity & continence support.
- 'Coping behaviours' which may present as challenging.
- Mental health difficulties.
- Autism Spectrum Disorder
- Learning disability and behaviours that challenge.
- Those with a learning disability transitioning into adult services.









We've developed a well equipped three bedroom property in a safe and pleasant village setting, just outside Warwick.



To benefit from the CCNSS individuals will need to be:

- 18 30 years old.
- With a learning disability and a complex range of difficulties.
- Who require a 1:1 support service.
